**Report Redesign:** Within SQL Server Reporting Services, we meticulously recreated reports, employing modern design principles to present data cohesively and aesthetically.



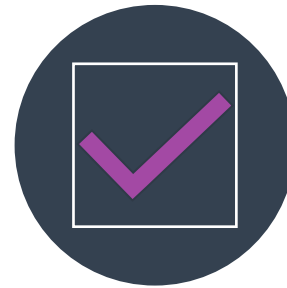
**User Training:** Client users underwent comprehensive training to familiarize themselves with the new SSRS interface, enabling them to proficiently generate and manage reports.

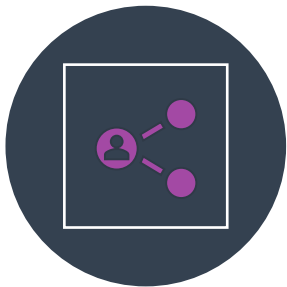
